GOALS OF THE CLARENCE & MARY LEE HOWARD CHARITY FOUNDATION

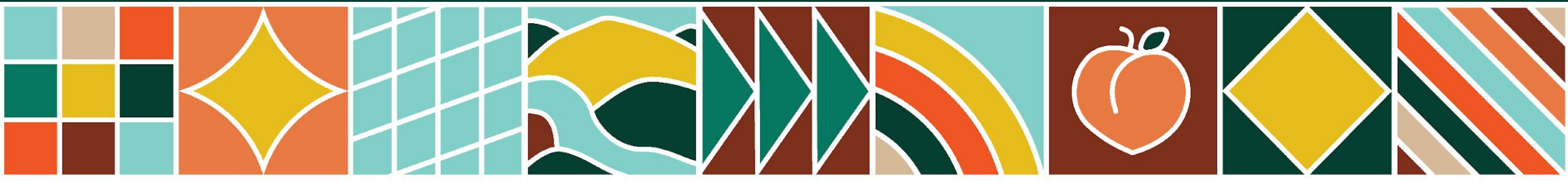
- 1. To provide educational enrichment programs
